## INFINITE POSSIBILITIES GRANT BASEF 2023 TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Bay Area Science and Engineering Fair will award a grant in the amount of "\$1000.00" (one thousand) Canadian dollars to a Science and Technology teacher, providing all of the following guidelines are met:

- 1. The Ontario Certified Teacher teaches any science and/or technology curriculum in grades 4-12
- 2. The teacher is from a publicly funded school board in the BASEF catchment area
- 3. The teacher has filled out an application indicating how the funds will be used in their classroom (e.g., purchase of curriculum materials, purchase of student science project materials, field trip costs, program registrations etc)
- 4. The teacher has agreed to provide an update on how the funds were used and the impact it had on curriculum delivery and student engagement related to science and technology.
- 5. The teacher agrees to register students in the 2023 Bay Area and Engineering Fair. If students are in grades 4-6, teachers must agree to hold a science and engineering fair event in their classroom to showcase students' inquiries.
- 6. Applications must be submitted by Friday, October 7th at midnight.

BASEF will issue a cheque to the school to be used for the purchase of materials or to aid in experiential learning in science and technology.
